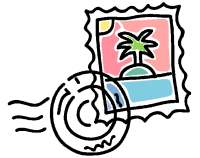


Stamp Ministry

1. Can feel like being Blind-Sided

Having trouble hearing during the worship service? We have hearing assist devices available to make you worship more enjoyable. Simply ask for one from the sound system operator.

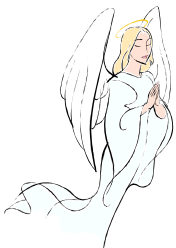


3. Reveals His Power
