“A Risen Faith” is...

### 1. *Anchored in Truth*

*"So she came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved, and said, 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!'" (v 2)*

### 2. *Manifested by Grace*

*"Woman," he said, "why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?" (v 15)*

### 3. *Responds in Love*

*"Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet returned to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, 'I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" (v 17)*
