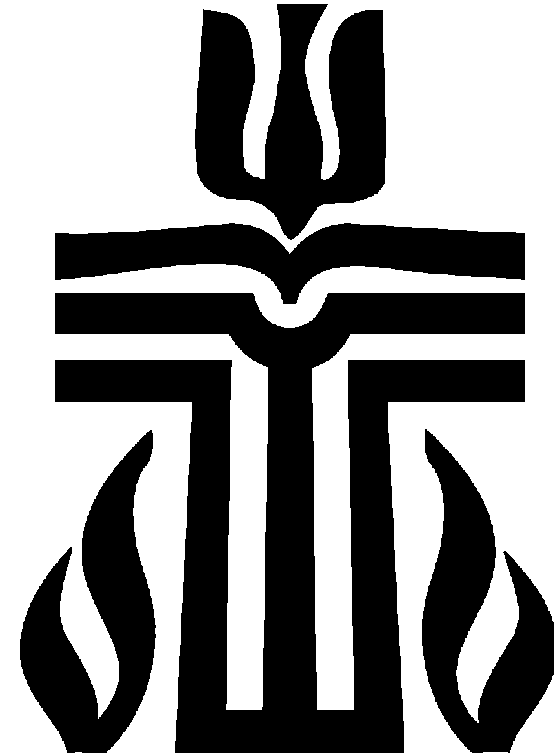
Our Mission
