Matthew 19:16-25 (NIV)

1. The Problem

*"Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." (v 24)*

2. The Solution

*"Jesus answered, 'If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.'" (v 21)*
