SERMON NOTES – “Relationship & Response in the Word” Luke 9:28-36 (NIV)

1. The Relationship

“As the men were leaving Jesus, Peter said to him, “Master, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.” (He did not know what he was saying.)” (v 33)

2. The Response

“Two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. They spoke about his departure, which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem.” (vv 30-31)
