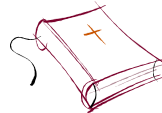
K-CEPS Food for the Holidays

1. Unedited

2. Offered with Authority

3. Relational

“O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!” (vv. 1 & 9)
