**SERMON NOTES – “Genesis: The Plan of Redemption”**  
Genesis 3:20-24 (NIV)

The Plan of Redemption is found in

1. A Name

*"Adam named his wife Eve, because she would become the mother of all the living." (v 20)*

2. A Sacrifice

*"The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them." (v 21)*

3. An Ultimate Sacrifice

*"...he placed on the east side of the Garden of Eden cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life." (v 24)*
